

Resident Council Meeting Minutes

July 19, 2017 at 11:15 a.m.

Present: 30 residents, 6 staff, 1 family member.

1. Amos opened with prayer
2. Debbie led the meeting and reviewed a number of activities and special events that took place over the past couple of months.
